

Khel Utsav 2019

CMS Business School, Jain (Deemed-to-be University)'s popular, flagship annual sports event "**Khel Utsav 2019**" was held from 4 to 8 February 2019 with an overwhelming response from participants (students, faculty, non-teaching staff and support staff) as well as with the unstinting support from volunteers.

The week-long sports event aims to foster a spirit of sportsmanship among students and faculty, to celebrate and promote health and fitness, to encourage and appreciate the sporting talent and to build team spirit. The event also seeks to provide the students and faculty with a medium to de-stress and break the monotony of structured classroom activities. The diverse line-up of sporting events also offers the students an opportunity to play with passion and enthusiasm.

Information regarding Khel Utsav and the specific sporting events were shared with students and faculty through several media: class talk and announcements, notice board displays, WhatsApp messages and posts on the college website as well as the college Facebook page. The event was open to all students, teaching and non-teaching members of CMS b-school to participate irrespective of prior training, experience, or knowledge. Elaborate arrangements were made for the smooth run of indoor as well as outdoor sports events. About 150 students registered and participated directly in the events, while the rest cheered or volunteered. About 35 teaching faculty members and non-teaching support staff also participated in Khel Utsav 2019. Announcements were widely made before the event, inclusive of a countdown to D-day. Online registrations were invited, which elicited a good response, with more than 150 students registering – many for multiple sports. The itinerary was prominently displayed, and a competent team of 15 student volunteers ran the show.

Inaugural Session:

Khel Utsav 2019 was formally inaugurated with the customary delivery of sportsmanship oath and the conduct of Faculty Tug-o-War, which attracted a sizeable number of participants. The first event itself set the tone for focus, fun, and sportsmanship.
