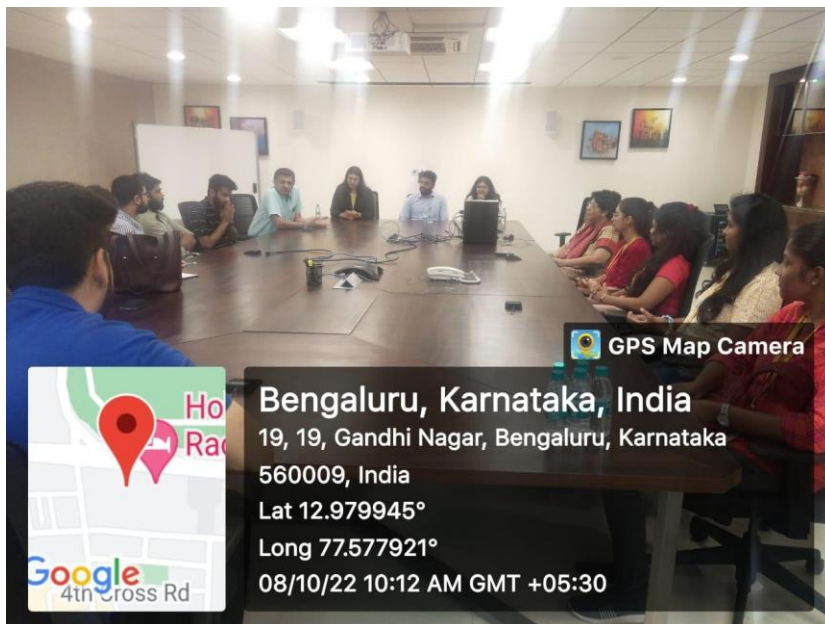


Fig 1.1 Panelists interacting with CHR and semester –I students
