## **5.**Activity Overview:

The 105<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference was organized by IEA (Indian Economic Association) and hosted by CMS Business School, JAIN (Deemed to be University) Seshadri Road, Bengaluru between 27<sup>th</sup> Dec and 29<sup>th</sup> Dec-2022.

IEA is a registered body of Indian Economics professionals established in 1917 with the objective of providing a forum for discussions and debates relating to theoretical and policy-oriented issues of economics science. IEA, the oldest association in social sciences organizes annual conferences, and



by eminent professionals. It aims at promoting the interests of the economics discipline in terms of expansion and professional competence in teaching, training, research and consultancy.

JAIN (Deemed-to-be University) is ranked among the top universities of India and is considered a cerebral destination for students across the world and Bangalore. Currently, he is also Vice Chairman, Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Good Governance and Policy Analysis; and ex-officio Vice Chairman of Madhya Pradesh State Policy and Planning Commission. He is also Member, Board of Governors, Reserve Bank of India.



**Prof. V.K. Malhotra** has recently been appointed as Chairman, Food Commission of Madhya Pradesh. He has served as Member Secretary, Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Government of India, New Delhi for two consecutive terms (October 2016 to 2022). He has earlier served at C.C.S University as Head and Professor of Economics. His research interests include Governance and Economic Development, Corporate Governance and Performance, Intellectual Property Rights and India's Concerns, Foreign Trade and Investments etc.

**Dr. Charan Singh** is the former Non-Executive Chairman of Punjab & Sind Bank. He was full time visiting faculty and former RBI Chair Professor (Dec 2012 to Dec 2016) at the Indian Institute of Management Bangalore, India where he taught comparative monetary policy and policy issues in Indian economy.



**Dr. M. Govinda Rao** is the Director National Institute of Public Finance and Policy.
