5. Activity Overview:

The 105th Annual Conference was organized by IEA (Indian Economic Association) and hosted by CMS Business School, JAIN (Deemed to be University) Seshadri Road, Bengaluru between 27th Dec and 29th Dec-2022.

IEA is a registered body of Indian Economics professionals established in 1917 with the objective of providing a forum for discussions and debates relating to theoretical and policy-oriented issues of economics science. IEA, the oldest association in social sciences organizes annual conferences, and

by eminent professionals. It aims at promoting the interests of the economics discipline in terms of expansion and professional competence in teaching, training, research and consultancy.

JAIN (Deemed-to-be University) is ranked among the top universities of India and is considered a cerebral destination for students across the world and Bangalore. Prof. Ramesh Chand is currently member NITI Aayog, in the rank and status of a union minister of state. He has a PhD in agricultural economics from the Indian Agricultural Research Institute (IARI).

New Delhi. He is a fellow of the National Academy of Agricultural Sciences and the Indian society of Agricultural Economics. He has been involved in policy formulation for the agricultural sector for the past two and a half decades. Prior to joining NITI Aayog, he was Director, National Institute of Agricultural Economics and policy Research, New Delhi.



Prof. Sachin Chaturvedi is currently Director General at the Research and Information System for Developing Countries (RIS), a New Delhi-based Think-Tank. Currently, he is also Vice Chairman, Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Good Governance and Policy Analysis; and ex-officio Vice Chairman of Madhya Pradesh State Policy and Planning Commission. He is also Member, Board of Governors, Reserve Bank of India.



Prof. V.K. Malhotra has recently been appointed as Chairman, Food Commission of Madhya Pradesh. He has served as Member Secretary, Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Government of India, New Delhi for two consecutive terms (October 2016 to 2022). He has earlier served at C.C.S University as Head and Professor of Economics. His research interests include Governance and Economic Development, Corporate Governance and Performance, Intellectual Property Rights and India's Concerns, Foreign Trade and Investments etc.

He was invited to work at the South Centre (organization), Geneva, by Julius Nyerere, the former President of Tanzania, and the then Chairman of the group.



Dr. Charan Singh is the former Non-Executive Chairman of Punjab & Sind Bank. He was full time visiting faculty and former RBI Chair Professor (Dec 2012 to Dec 2016) at the Indian Institute of Management Bangalore, India where he taught comparative monetary policy and policy issues in Indian economy.



Dr. M. Govinda Rao is the Director National Institute of Public Finance and Policy. His past positions include Director, Institute for Social and Economic Change, (1998-2002) Bangalore (1998-2002) and Fellow, Research School of Pacific and Asian Studies, Australian National University, Canberra, Australia (1995-1998) and Professor, National Institute of Public Finance and Policy (1985-1995). 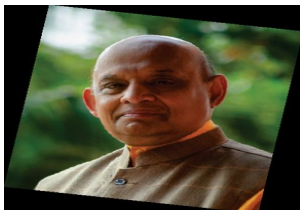

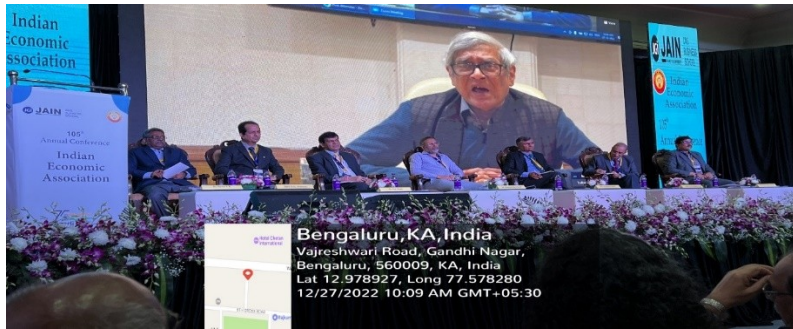


Figure 1: Dr. Bibek Debroy addressed the gathering online due to his busy schedule on the 1st day of the conference dated 27/12/2022

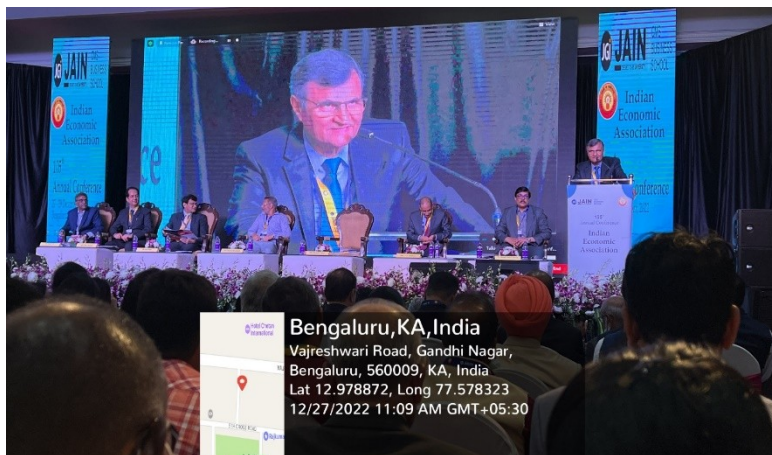


Figure 3: Prof Ramesh Chand member NITI Aayog, in the rank and status of a Union Minister of State addressed the gathering on the inauguration of the conference on 27/12 2022. he addressed related to the policy formulation for the agricultural sector.
