The FDP on “**Research Publications**” was organized by CMS Business School, Jain University which was held on **24th March, 2016**. It was a national level faculty development program and the event was divided into four sessions.

The first session was held by Dr. Pit Pichappan senior scientist, Digital Information Research Foundation (DIRF), Chennai, and Guest Professor at Zhejiang University, China.

He elaborated on “**Strategies and Tools for Quality Publications**” and highlighted various strategies that can be adopted while writing publications. In the second session he discussed “**Standards in scientific writing**” where he emphasized the style of writing and connectivity in between paragraphs. He gave tips on how to write scientifically and also further discussed some other aspects of scientific writing.

The third session was conducted by Dr. M Krishnamurthy a highly learned person on the topic “**Publication quality, citation measures and plagiarism**”. Dr. M Krishnamurthy spoke about the quality of content and the accurate way of using citations, and how to obtain permission to use the written work of other authors. He discussed the growing plagiarism and the different tools that can identify it and how one must maintain authenticity of their research.

Once again the fourth session was conducted by Dr. Pit Pichappan on the topic “**Practical illustrations for quality publications**”. He concluded the event by wishing all the participants which consisted of more than 200 scholars, researchers and teachers from various colleges, universities and industries from different parts of the country. It was a great learning experience for the participants and they expressed their desire for more such programs in the future.
