








2. To what extent the session contributed to fostering collaboration between academia and industry to enhance knowledge in the field of general management? ^{16 responses}




3. In what ways do you think the session helped you implement real-world applications to improve pedagogical strategies and academic content in general management? ^{16 responses}






4. How has your awareness of contemporary industry dynamics and strategic approaches in general management been affected by these initiatives? ^{16 responses}
