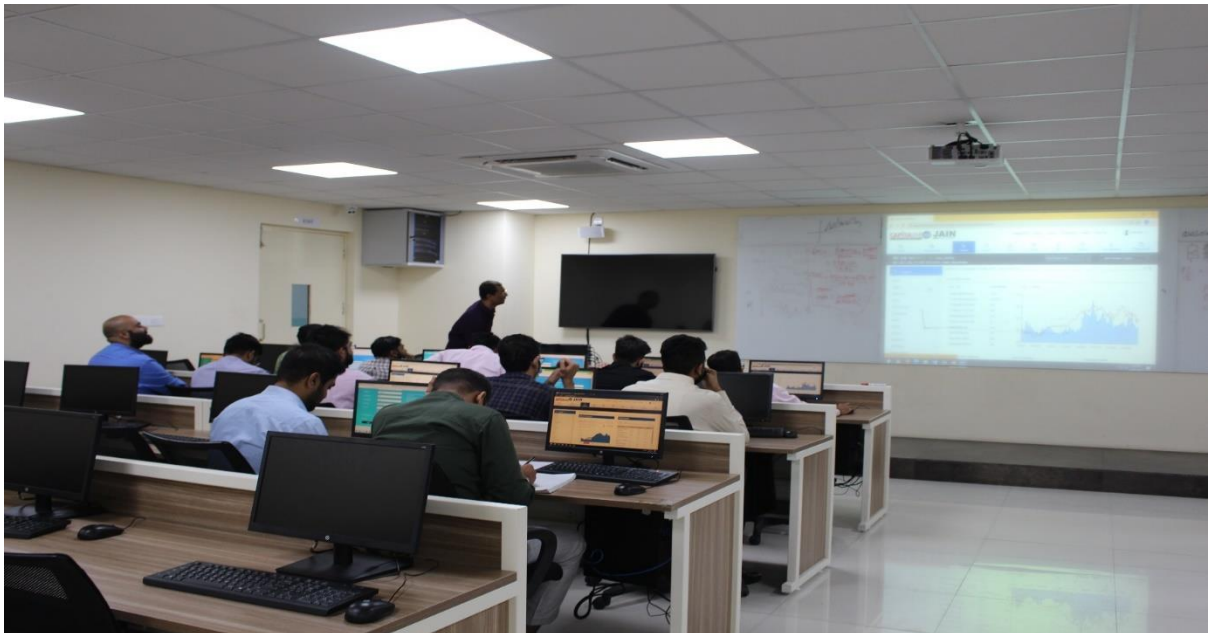


Fig 1.3. – FIG Activity –04-03-2022 – Students working on systems
