- **5. Activity Overview**: Team building in a diverse work environment is a crucial endeavor to foster inclusivity, improve communication, and enhance collaboration among employees from various backgrounds and perspectives. The speaker spoke on managing the team, resolving conflicts, cross cultural implications in the working environment.
- **6.** Guest/Speakers' Profile: Rachel Shetty is the Chairperson of Sports and Games, Rotary District 3192. Rachel was the Team Manager of the Indian under 19, Women's cricket team that won the first inaugural world cup in South Africa in January 2023. She was the administrative Head of Cricket Operations for men and women at the Karnataka State Cricket Academy. She was the assistant coach/manager of the Karnataka state women's senior cricket team. In her younger days, she represented the Indian probable's and played against England. She represented the Karnataka state women's senior cricket team, South zone team and captained the under 16 Karnataka team. On her professional front, she is a Guest lecturer of sports management at PES college Bangalore. Prior to this she was the Senior Director of American Express for 24 years. She won the Ambassador's award at American Express for her leadership and performance. She left the corporate space for her passion for women's cricket. She conducts several workshops like Campus to Corporate at different colleges.

On her educational front, she has an MBA in computer information systems from New York University, USA and MA from Bangalore University. She has a black belt in Six Sigma from the United States. She is a certified IELTS trainer from British Council. Completed the sport's essentials from Columbia University, New York.






Fig 2. Faculty members of Marketing department interacting with guest speaker during the session.






Fig 3. From left DR. Govindaraj, Dr Satish Kumar, Dr. Anantha Subramanya Iyer and Dr. Raja Shankaran during the session.
